

## Do you compare your child's development to other children their age?

*The Chesapeake Infant Intervention Program works with you to address your concerns.*



Do you have any concerns about your baby's development? Maybe you compare your child to other children at the park, at birthday parties, or even to their older siblings. You may notice your child is not talking like other children or your child may not be walking. In child development, there are typical developmental milestones children reach such as:

Important Milestones	
<p><b><u>By 3 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your baby lift her head and chest when lying on her tummy?</li><li>♥ Does your baby watch you when you walk across the room?</li></ul>	<p><b><u>By 6 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your baby laugh and babble?</li><li>♥ Does your baby roll from his back to his tummy?</li></ul>
<p><b><u>By 12 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your baby pull up to standing by holding onto the furniture?</li><li>♥ Does your baby pick up small things using his thumb and index finger?</li></ul>	<p><b><u>By 18 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your baby point to body parts when you name them?</li><li>♥ Does your baby drink from a cup?</li></ul>
<p><b><u>By 24 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your child put two words together (like "car go")?</li><li>♥ Does he stack things on top of one another?</li></ul>	<p><b><u>By 36 Months of Age . . .</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>♥ Does your child ask questions?</li><li>♥ Does your child know her first name?</li></ul>

The Chesapeake Infant Intervention Program provides early intervention supports and services to infants and toddlers from birth to three years of age who are not developing as expected or who have a medical condition that may delay normal development. Early intervention supports and services focus on increasing the child's participation in family and community activities that are important to the family. In addition, supports and services focus on helping parents and other caregivers know how to find ways to help the child learn during everyday activities. These supports and services are available for all eligible children and their families regardless of the family's ability to pay.
